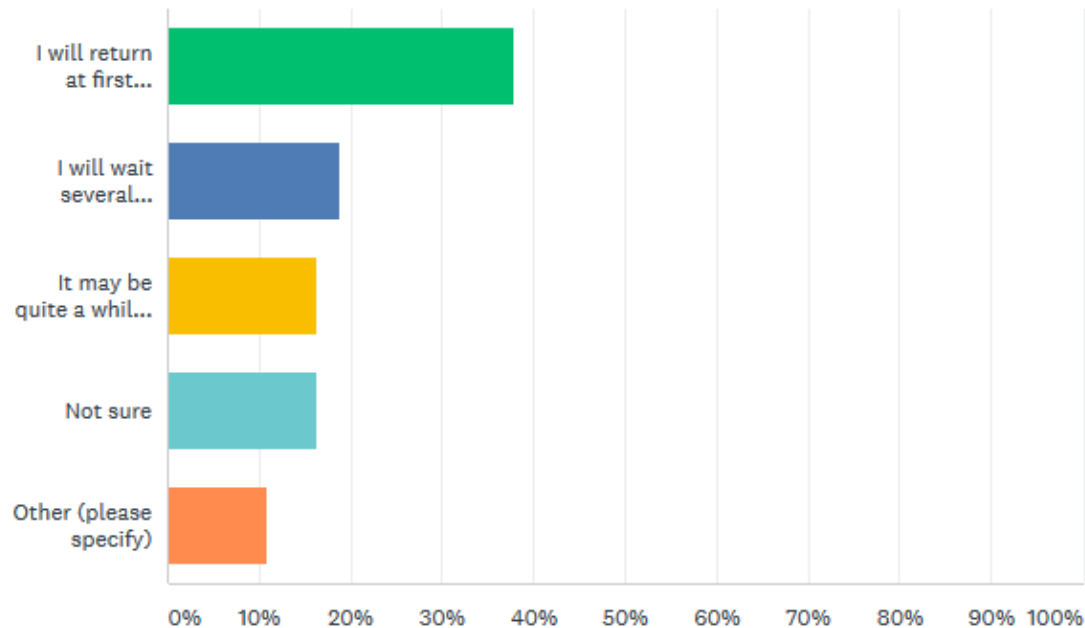

# General Notes

- 18 questions/75 responses
  - 29 respondents said they were answering on behalf of their family
    - If you were to presume that the “family unit” included one other member of the Church, the survey could represent  $75+29=104$  members
- In this presentation, a graphical analysis by question is followed by text responses for that question, where applicable (other, concerns/comments)
- Note that where multiple responses were allowed, percentages of responses ARE NOT additive: For example, if X% of the respondents answered A and Y% answered B, it can not conclude that X+Y% answered A or B
  - As an example, see Questions 8 & 9 (Would you be willing to attend church on a different day and which day(s) would you attend?) for an example analysis

1. When our local government lifts its ban or guidance against large public gatherings, which best describes your attitude toward returning to a worship service at Church? Select one:

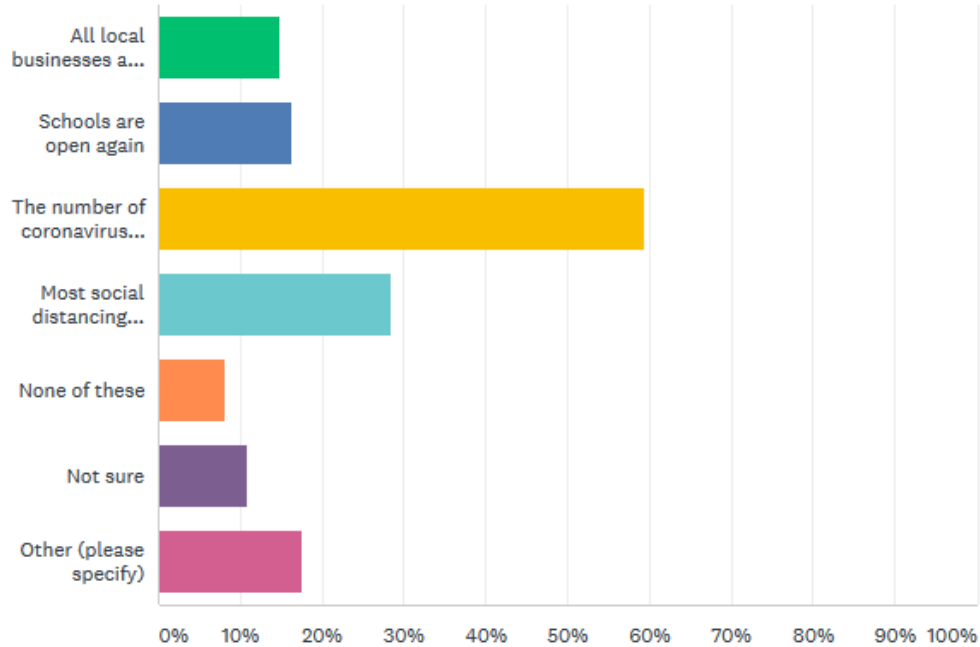

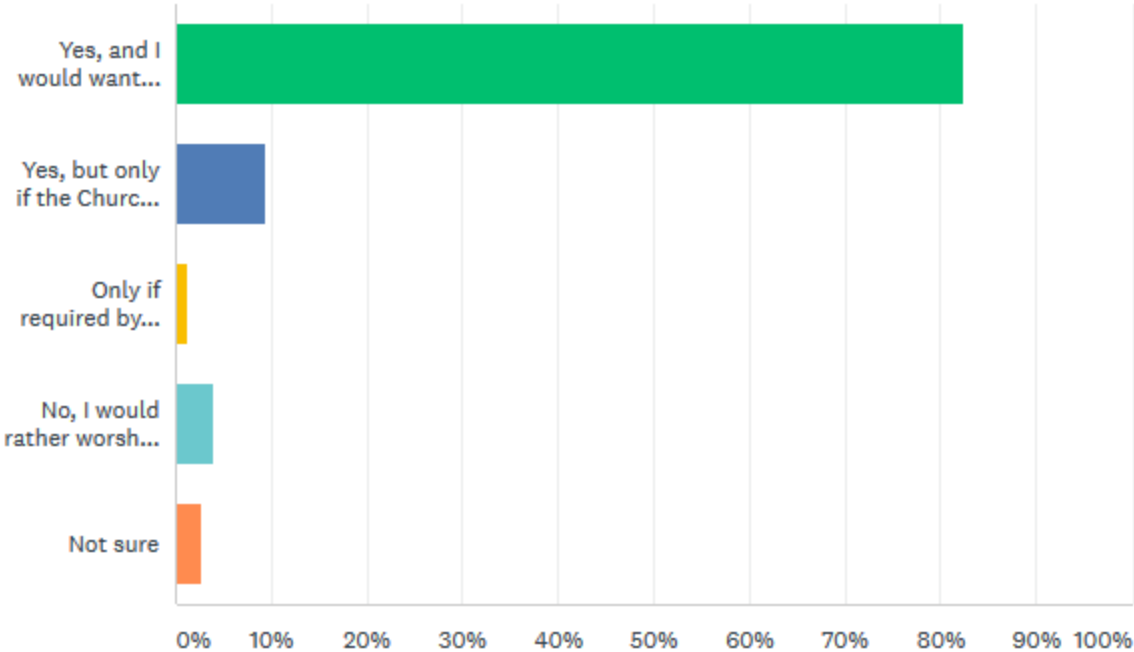

### 3. Would you be willing to wear a face mask?

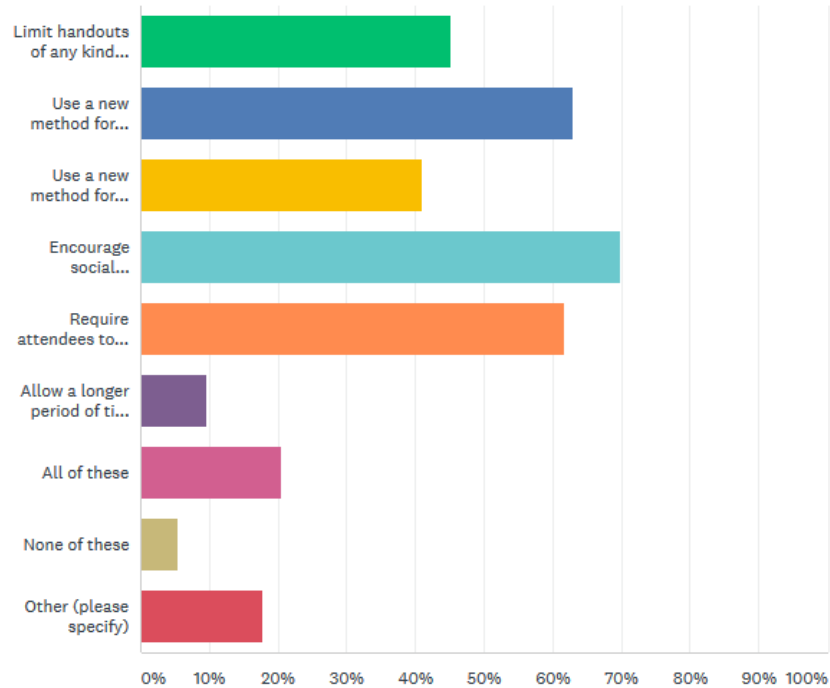

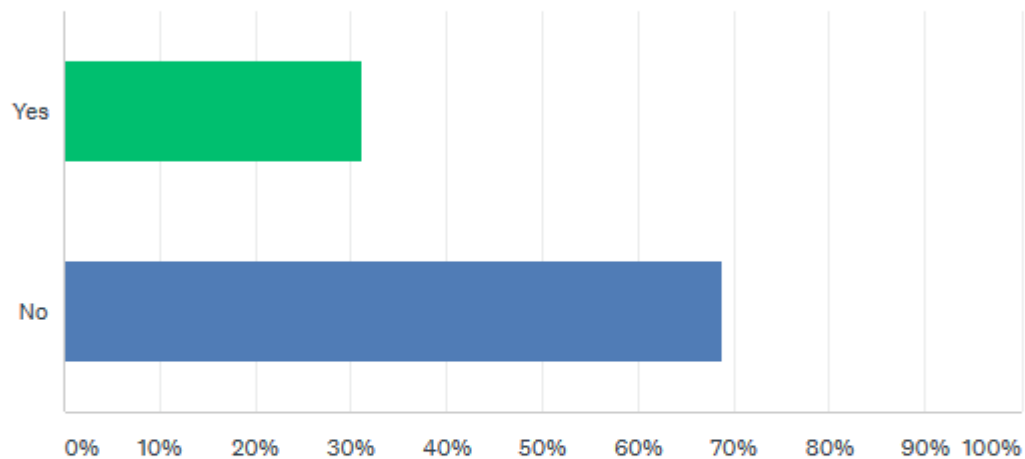

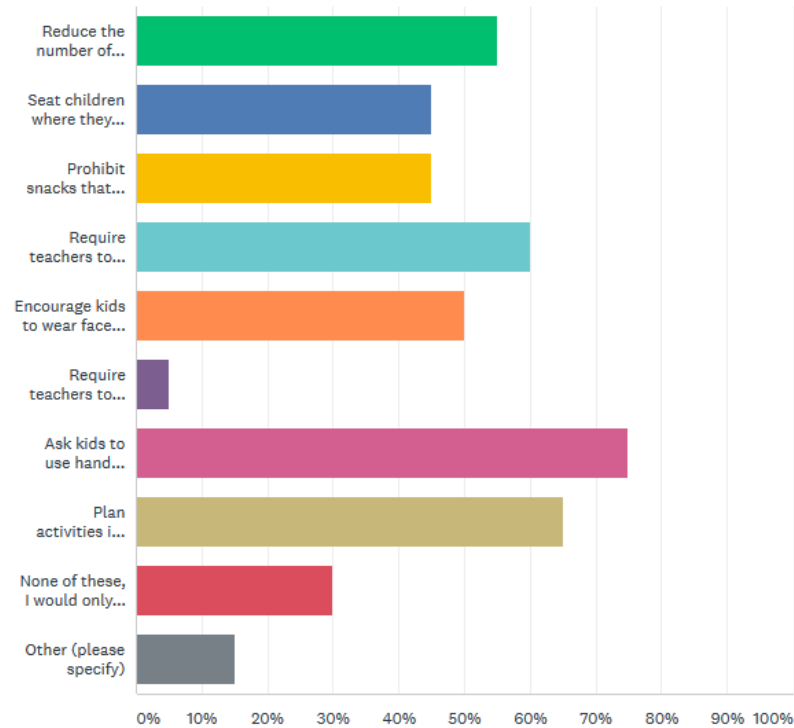

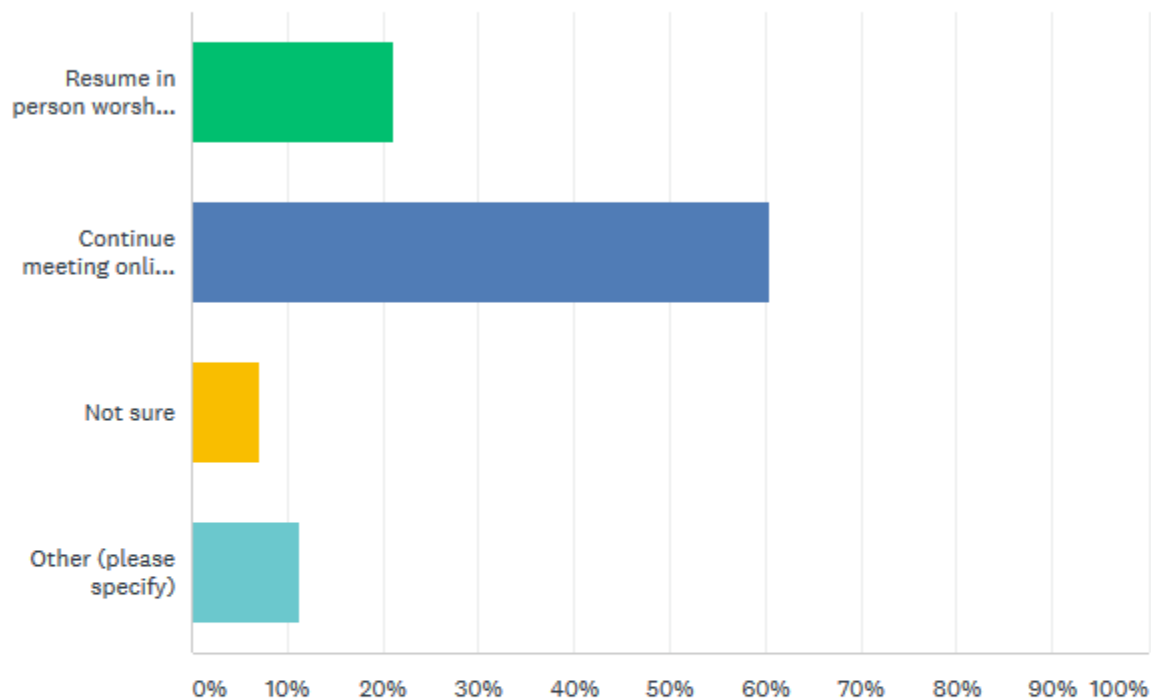

## 7. When our local government lifts its ban or guidance against public gatherings, which of the following would you prefer?

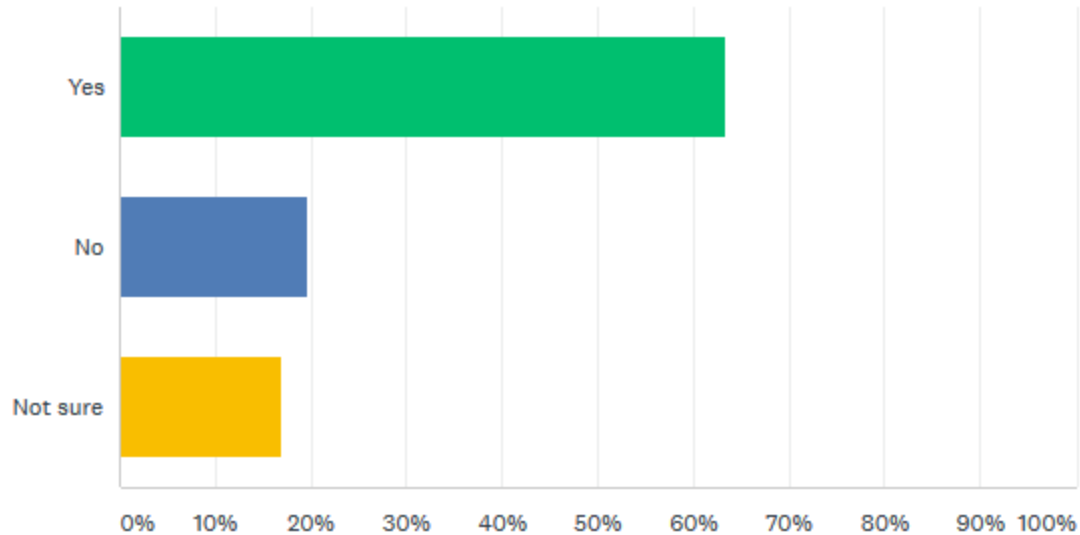

8. Would you be willing to attend a worship service on a different day or different time than you typically attend to allow people to be more spread out in the sanctuary?

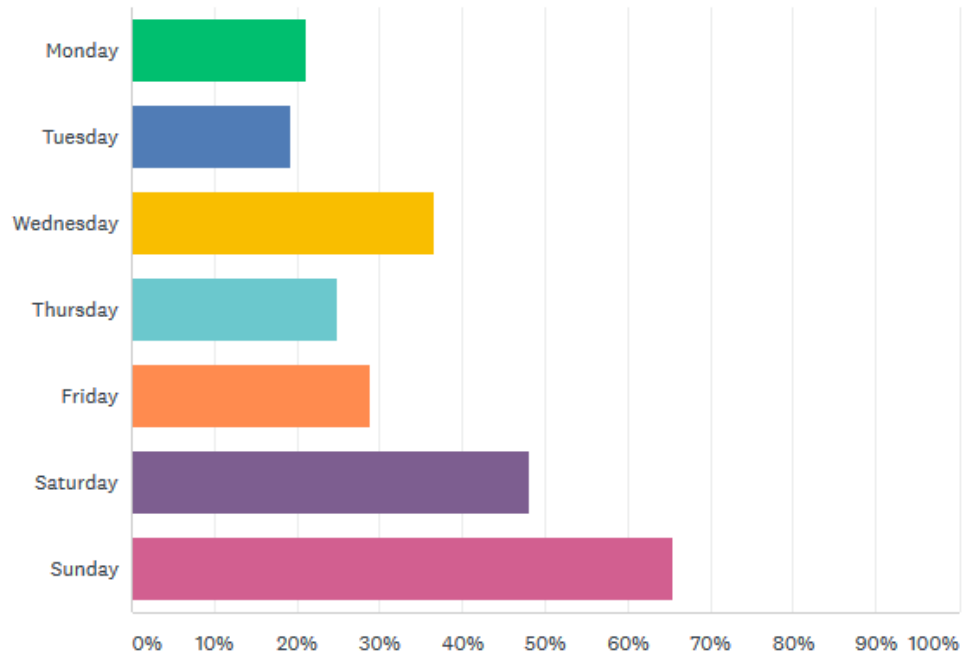

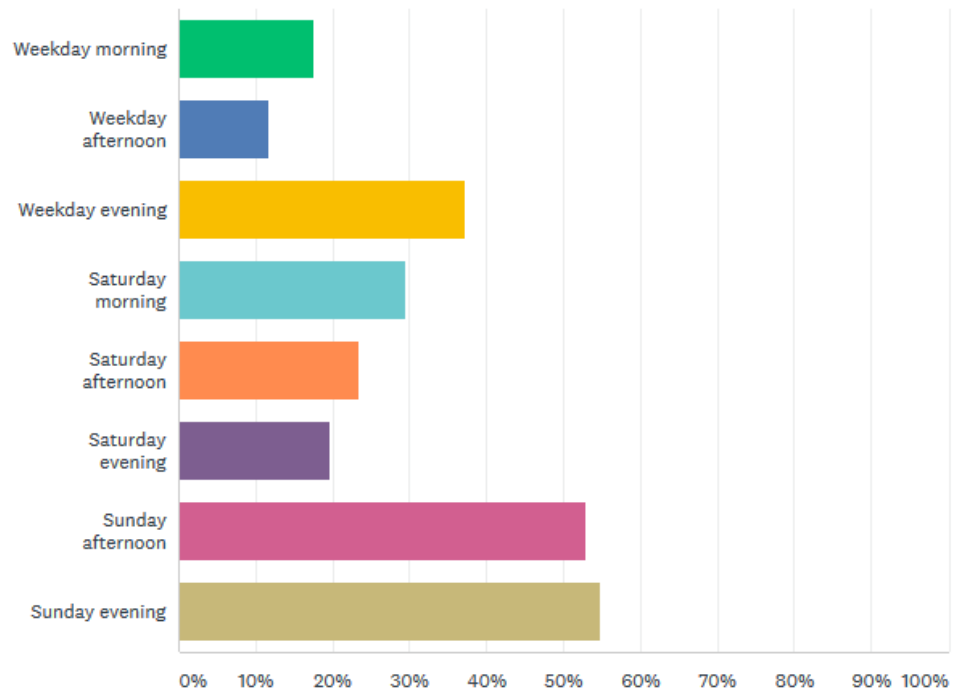

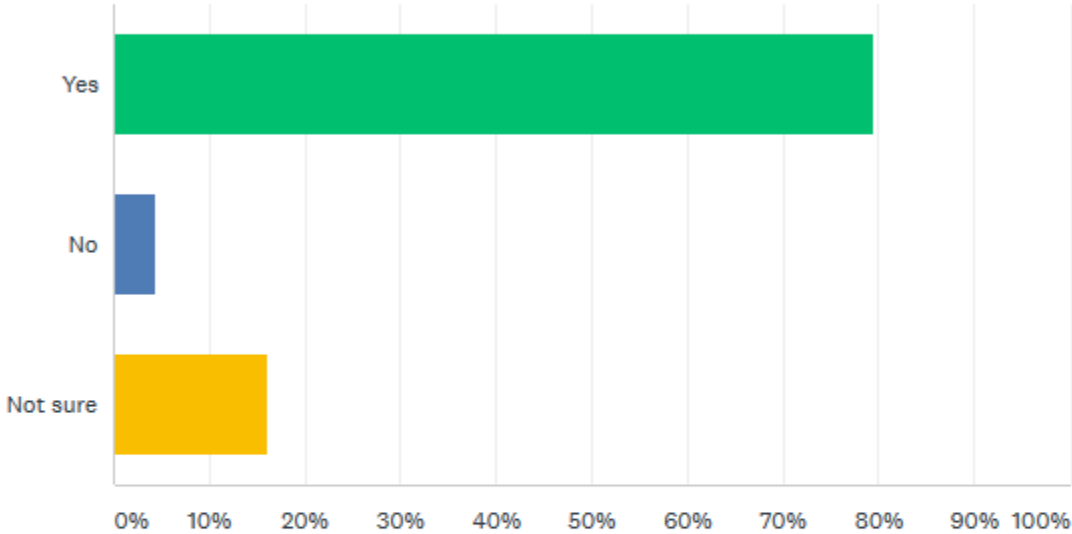

# 11. Would you be willing to attend a worship service in the Chapel or the Fellowship Hall to ensure people in the Sanctuary are spread out?

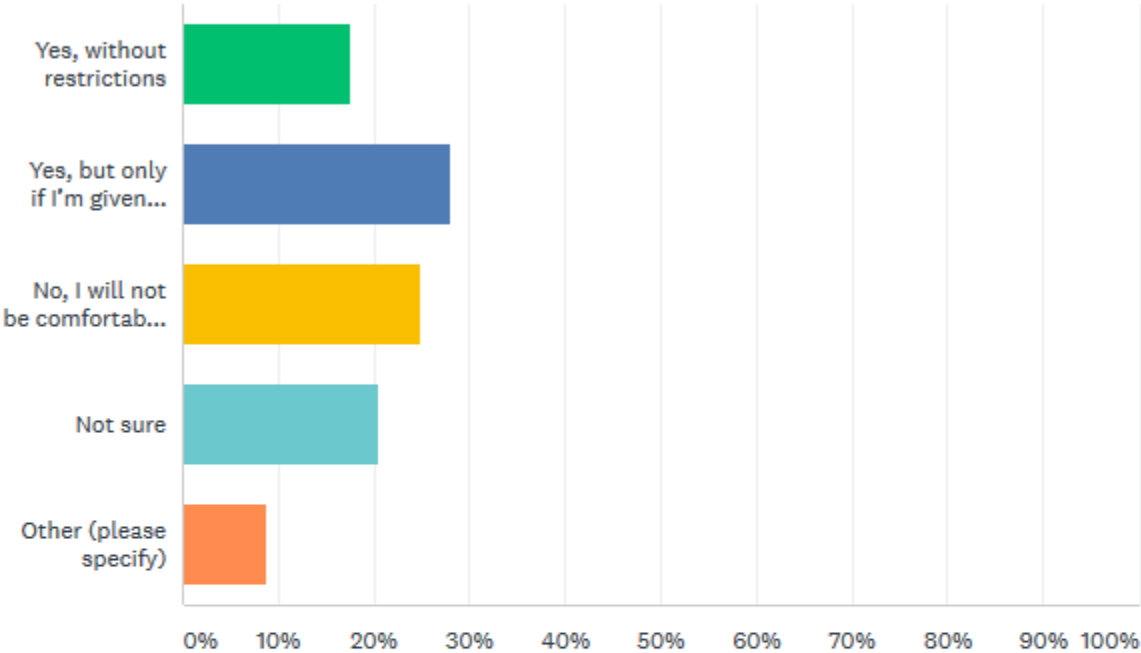

# 12. Would you be willing to return to volunteer as an usher or liturgist on Sunday mornings once we reopen for in-person worship services?

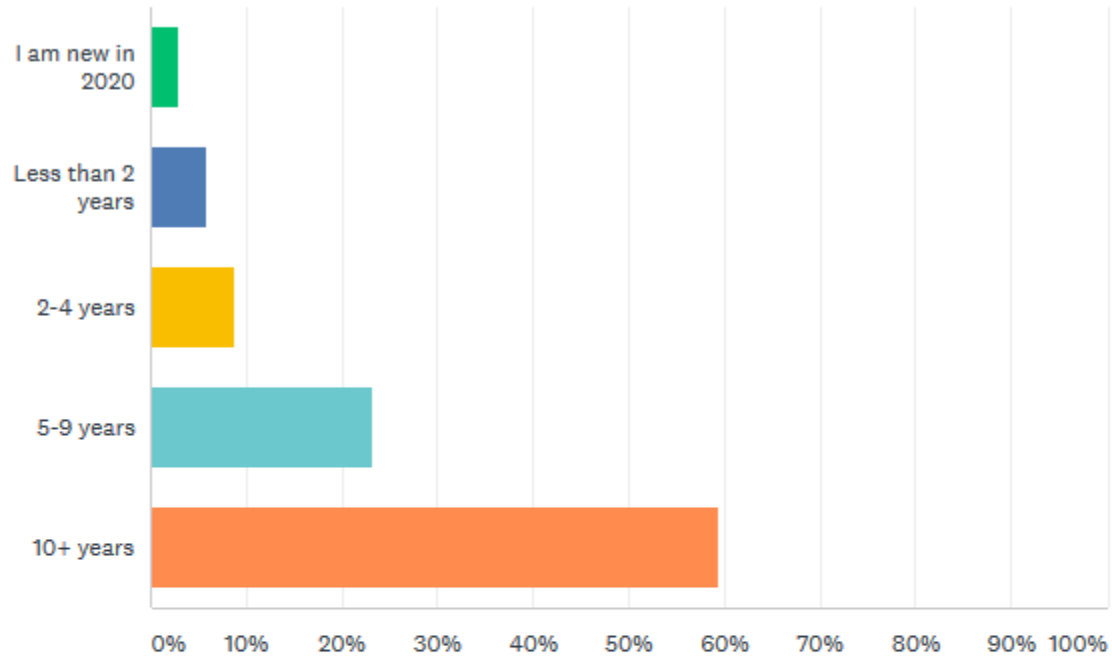

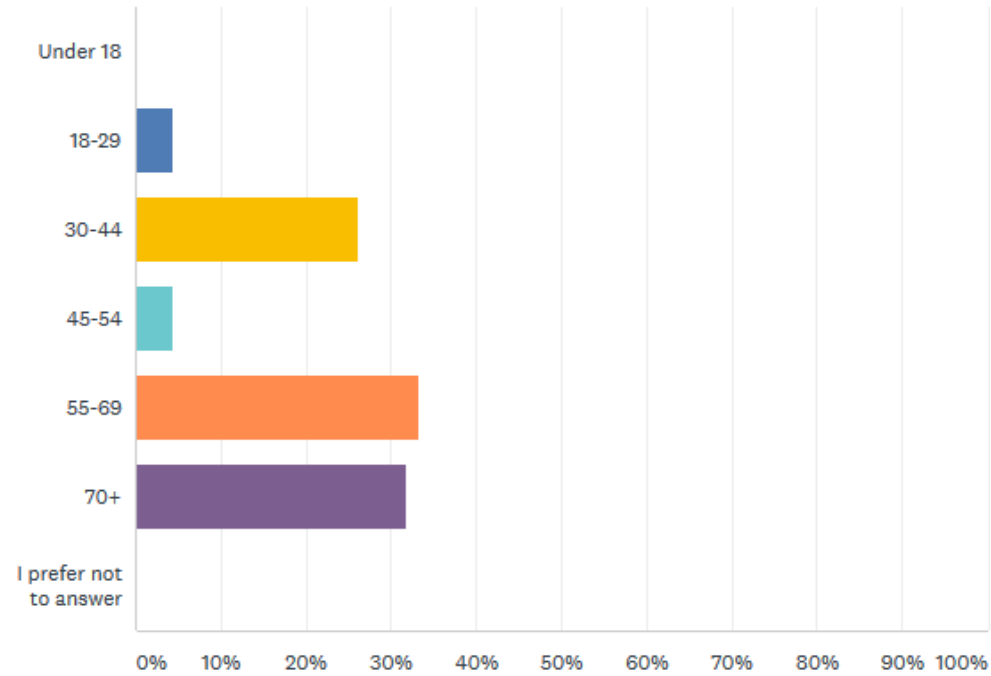

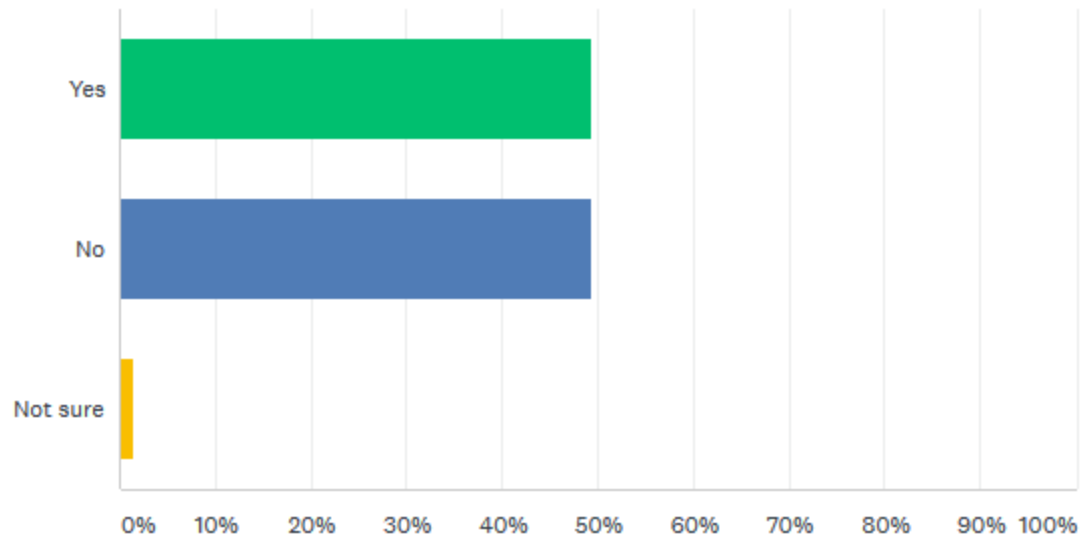

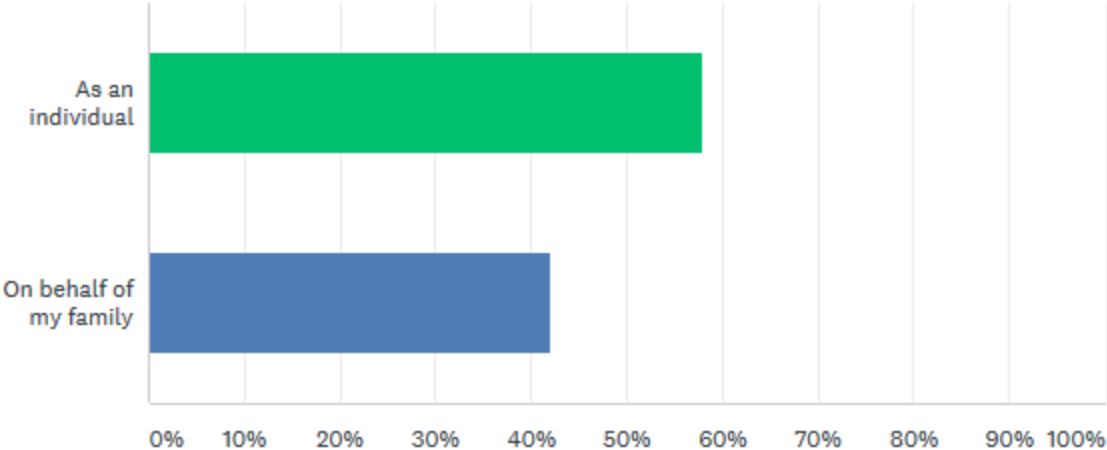
