Get a local produce share!

Many local farms are offering produce boxes to the community, whether or not you have a CSA (seasonal share in the farm). Supporting local farmers in this way helps them maintain operations despite the lack of revenue at the usual Farmers Markets. Support local jobs and local agriculture all while saving a trip to the grocery store and maintaining social distancing!

Call the farmers from your favorite market stall, they likely have something in place to accommodate you. For example, Joseph Fields Farm has pick up locations throughout the greater Charleston area on Wednesdays or you can check out delivery options through <u>Community Supported Grocery</u>.

If you are interested but, for whatever reason, don't feel comfortable leaving the house, please get in touch with a deacon or church staff so that we can connect you with a neighbor who'd be willing to drop off your produce share. Similarly, get in touch if there are other errands you need run. We're in this together and, despite the physical distance, there are so many people who would like to help.
